#### **DIRECTIONS:**

The Rutgers Club is now located on the Livingston Campus in Piscataway, not on College Avenue, and not near the Rutgers Inn and Conference Center. The most direct route is from Route 18, toward Rutgers Athletic Center (RAC). You can also use the address of the James Carr Library (formerly Kilmer Library) in a GPS since it is closest to the parking. The Library address is 75 Avenue E, Piscataway, NJ 08854-8040.

Visitor parking is in the first two rows closest to the library. Follow the path past the front of the library and follow signs to The Rutgers Club from there.
